Central to the Academic Summer experience is the innovative methodology known as CLIL, which stands for 'Content and Language Integrated Learning.' This approach enriches our courses with a holistic and dynamic educational framework. CLIL seamlessly integrates the acquisition of language skills with the exploration of subject content.

Content and Language Integrated Learning is based on the 4Cs:

- Cognition thinking and learning skills
- Communication sharing our ideas effectively with others

From interactive workshops, masterclasses, seminar classes to hands-on activities, we foster a profound connection between language and content. MASTERCLASSES WITH GUEST SPEAKERS

Designed for young learners age 10 to 13, this course is open to day students where theory meets practice in a dynamic exploration of all the subject areas.

We will help you prepare for your future studies, and at the same time improve your English language skills. You will explore a series of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) and Social Studies (History, Politics, Business, Sociology and Geography) subjects. This course follows a CLIL approach allowing students to learn the subject and the English Language simultaneously.


Career Pathway Programmes



THE FINAL ASSESSMENT


You will carry out a research project on a topic that interests you, and at the end of the course, you will present this to a panel of experts and your peers.

Family Programme

Our family programme is a flexible course for parents and children (10-17 years) who want to visit London together and combine quality language learning with the option for their children to take part in our Academic Summer School programmes.

Parents join our adult General English morning classes while their children study in separate classes with our partner Academic Summer Camps. In the afternoon parents can choose to participate in our varied social programme for adults whilst their children take part in our fun and educational excursions and workshops with their classmates on the Summer Camp programme. On these trips both parents and children can practise their English skills and also see many of London's famous sights.

Classes start in the morning and finish at lunchtime, leaving the afternoons to enjoy London. Students will get 15 hours of lesson time per week. Regular homework and in class tests will be given. Discounts are available after three weeks' of lessons.
