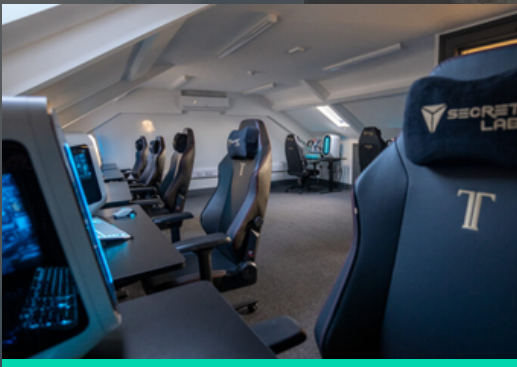

- Understand the importance of both physical and mental fitness, as well as health and nutrition for professional Esports players.


