1 - WHAT TO PACK IN YOUR CHILD'S SUITCASE:

CLOTHES

- Shorts / skirts
- T-shirts
- Underwear
- Light pyjamas
- Trousers (jean style)
- Dresses
- Sweater for the evening
- Socks
- Pair of sandals (flip flops, crocks...)
- 1 light jacket (in case of rain)
- Walking Shoes

(A) VARIOUS

- Pocket money (around 80-100 € per week)
- ID picture
- Padlock with key
- Water flask
- Cell phone / charger (optional)
- Adaptor for French plug
- Avoid precious objects: jewelry, electronic games etc.

JUST IN CASE

Medicaments if needed (in origin boxes with prescription)



PERSONAL ITEMS

- Soap, shampoo (attention to aircrafts allowance)
- Toothbrush, toothpaste
- 1 Towel
- Shower flip flops
- Deodorant, tissues
- Lenses / Glasses
- Hairbrush
- Hair gel, mousse, rubber or elastic head band
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen (high protection)
- Laundry bag

2 - FIRST STEPS IN FRANCE: ARRIVAL!

.... IMPORTANT NOTES

It is compulsory that you provide us no later than the 4 weeks before your child's arrival, the details of his arrival (time, flight number or train number, where he is arriving, Unaccompanied Minor "UM" service).

RECEPTION UPON ARRIVAL

AIRPORT:

A shared transfer is organized to the campus. Upon his/her arrival in Nice International airport, your child will be met by our representative who will be wearing a yellow CIA T-shirt. We are offering several shared transfers during the day (approximately 2 in the morning and 3 in the afternoon). That means that before being transferred to the campus, your child may have to wait, the time to gather students arriving via other incoming flights (2 hours maximum). Your child will be supervised by a member of our staff during any waiting time spent at the airport.

TRAIN STATION:

A member of our staff will be present at the exit of the train station to welcome your child and ensure his/her transfer to the campuses.

.... NOTES

If your child experiences any difficulties upon arrival, please ask him/her to go to the information desk at "Arrivals" or "Departures" and ask to contact us on this emergency number: (33) (0)4 92 90 71 70

IF YOUR CHILD IS TRAVELLING AS AN UNACCOMPANIED MINOR ("UM" SERVICE):

Your child will be picked up from the air hostess by one of our managers. We will let you know the name at the reservation. It is essential that you provide that name to the airline in order for your child to be handed over to our team.

. NOTES

We will not be able to guarantee the presence of our manager on the ground if you haven't subscribed to the "UM" service pick up 2 weeks before your child's arrival. Please make sure to complete the "UM" file and pay the service to the airline for your child's return journey.



3 - ON SITE ORGANISATION

RECEPTION THE DAY OF ARRIVAL:

On their arrival at campus, the students will be welcomed by our animation team that will provide them with a welcome pack including:

- The program for the weekly activities
- Their student card with the emergency number available 24/7
- A coloured bracelet depending on their activity group
- Our school rules (that they must sign)

Then our animation team will accompany them to their rooms. Finally, a guided visit of the campus as well as a welcome evening will allow them to discover the place and the other students.

Class attendance is compulsory!

Lists of students by class and level are displayed on Tuesday morning (school hall).

No courses on public holidays, lessons are replaced by full day excursion.

ANIMATION PROGRAM:

The activity program is adapted to the age of the student (8-11 years and 12-17 years).

In addition to the activities included, the animation team suggests «kiosk» activities: additional paying activities (Go Karting, Bowling, Laser quest, etc...) for 13 -17 years old. **You must complete the parent permission form to allow your child to participate.**

SHUTTLES:

The school organises daily shuttle buses to allow the students (13-17 y.o.) to travel from the campus to the city centre and the beaches.

Depending on the distance from the campus, the frequency of the shuttles changes but we organise them to ensure that the students can make the most of their free time.

- During the day: between 1:00pm and 7:00pm from Monday to Friday and from 9am to 7pm on Saturday and Sunday.
- During the evening: between 8:30 pm and 10:00 pm from Monday to Thursday and between 8:30 pm to 1:00 am on Friday, Saturday and the eve of public holidays.

.. NOTES

Specific schedules are displayed on the campus.

ROOM ACCESS:

Access to the rooms depends on the schedule posted on the campus. In general, rooms are closed:

FROM MONDAY TO FRIDAY

- From 8:45am to 12:00pm: during French lessons
- From 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm: during the activities/excursions

ON SATURDAY

■ From 9:30 am to 5:00 pm: during full day excursion / free day

ON SUNDAY

■ From 9:30 am to 3:00 pm: during full day excursion / free day

EACH EVENING

■ From 8:45 pm to 10:15 pm: during the evenings

During closing times, students are not permitted to go to their rooms.

ACCESS TO THE POOL:

Pool use is subject to the schedule on display on campus, and is used under supervision.





OUTINGS:

All outings are strictly controlled by our animators and covered by parental permission. The conditions of the permission to leave depend on the age of the child. Age is determined by the exact date of birth (day, month, year) and not just the year of birth. NO EXCEPTION WILL BE MADE.

8-12 YEARS OLD:

Outings only under supervision.

13 - 17 YEARS OLD:

ALL students have AUTOMATIC permission to go out unaccompanied until 7.30pm* maximum. NO AUTHORISATION to go out unaccompanied after 7.30 pm.

*Dinner is served at 7.00pm in the campus.

16 - 17 YEARS OLD:

ALL students have AUTOMATIC permission to go out unaccompanied until 7.30pm* maximum.

FOR THE EVENING, the parents must choose one of the options below:

OPTION 1: NO EVENING PERMISSION UNACCOMPANIED after 7:30 pm.

OPTION 2: AUTOMATIC EVENING PERMISSION as below:

- From Monday to Thursday until 10:00 pm maximum.
- Friday, Saturday and days prior to a bank holiday until 1am maximum.
- Sunday until 7.30pm maximum.

*Dinner is served at 7.00pm in the campus.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL:

Your child must respect the rules of the school.

- We reserve the right to take the necessary steps, going from a warning to different sanctions, towards the student who does not respect the rules.
- Any consumption of **alcohol or drugs** is prohibited as per French law. **Smoking is strictly prohibited** on the premises and particularly in your room.

... IMPORTANT NOTES

- Not respecting the rules regarding drugs, alcohol, violence, tobacco, theft, verbal or physical aggression, might lead to expulsion.
- In case of expulsion, parents will be informed and have 24h after the incident to provide the new departure details.


SUPERVISION:

1 supervisor for every 12 students aged 12-17

1 supervisor for every 8 students aged 8-11

ACCESSIBILITY FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Some rooms and classrooms are equipped to accommodate individuals with reduced mobility or those with disabilities.



SERVICES

MAILS:

In order for your child to receive mail, it is important to respect the following template:

Mr./Miss (Student surname and name)

Full postal address of the campus or Office - see addresses on page 8.

PRECIOUS OBJECTS:

It is recommended to check that your child does not have any valuable belongings on him/her.

The head of the school can keep sealed for the entire length of the trip passports or travel tickets on simple demand. In no way does the school accept cash, checks or any other type of payment method.

The school is not responsible for any eventual theft amongst students.

HOUSEKEEPING:

Rooms are completely cleaned once a week (on Saturday). Bed sheets are also changed once a week. A quick clean up takes place during the week but can't be compared to hotel housekeeping in anyway. Students are asked to keep their room tidy and to make their bed.

SHEETS AND TOWELS:

Sheets : Provided **Towels : NOT** provided

Laundry (2-4 € on average per wash).

For hygienic reasons, in campuses, **only disposable linen** are provided. For more comfort, you can bring your own bedsheets.

MEDICAL VISITS:

It is possible that your child may need a medical visit. The cost of the visit is his/her responsibility and immediately paid to the doctor who comes to visit him or whom he/she visited:

- Estimated price for a doctor who comes to see the patient: 45€
- Estimated price for a visit to a general practice doctor: 23€
- Estimated price for a visit to a specialised doctor: 45€

HOSPITAL STAYS:

If you live in the European Union, your child will have to present the European Health Insurance Card but it does not necessarily exempt from paying medical fees at the hospital.

In any case, you must pay of all the costs involved for your child before he/she is released from hospital, then you can contact your health insurance for a refund. You will have to reimburse all medical expenses that could possibly be engaged by CIA for your child within 48 hours.

POCKET MONEY:

We recommend 80€ to 100€ per week pocket money for the students.

Please note that there are 50€ administration fees if you want to send money to your child through the school.
