

Spanish classes, coffee, and fresh food breaks on the school's rooftop terrace or in its patio "Café de las buenas lenguas".












Ceramic painting is the heart and soul of the barrio de Triana, where you can learn to feel like a Spanish artist.


















#### **CULTURAL ACTIVITIES WITH CLIC CADIZ**

Mmm, yummy! You will be licking your fingers after learning how to cook paella.








