# THE LOCATION

IH Frensham Young Learner Centre is held in a private boarding school with excellent sports facilities and a theatre for music and performing arts, in the heart of the Surrey countryside, South East England.

Frensham is only 1.5 hours from central London

Frensham Common is owned by the National Trust and is a site of special interest.

Frensham Little Pond was created in the 13th century, when King Henry III was on the English throne. It was built to supply fish to the Bishop of Winchester.

The school has traditional academic buildings within impressive grounds, surrounded by beautiful woodland.

The fantastic facilities include tennis courts, heated swimming pool, high ropes adventure course, its own theatre, dance studio and a new music department.

The school sits between South Downs National Park and the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, and is only one hour from London.

Some optional activities may be offered: e-sports, pottery, analogue photography, afternoon tea experience.

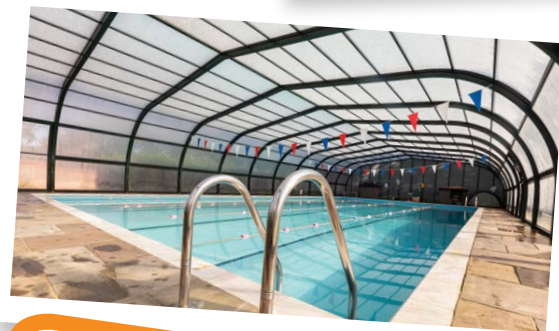

Students follow a daily programme of 15 lessons of English language in the morning, while afternoons are spent learning outside of the classroom through exciting activities with new friends.

During the afternoon, students can choose from a number of sports and arts activities, with something for everyone. Sports can include tennis, football and basketball. Arts activities can include t-shirt painting, sketching, and performance arts.

Study trips are also a big part of the course, with one full-day and one half-day trip to places of interest in the UK included every week. Example trips include: a full-day trip to London for a Shrek Adventure and a walking tour and Brighton including the Brighton i360, the famous Pier and the Lanes. Half-day trips include Windsor Castle.

Students practise their English inside and outside of the classroom, for the best learning experience.

In the evenings, Discover English students will have an activity programme with a mix of sports, art and crafts, and other activities such as quizzes and film night.

## Course content

Unlike our other Young Learner English programmes, this course has English lessons in both the morning and in the afternoon: 21 hours of English tuition per week by a qualified English teacher. It is an intensive course across English reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.

It is not all hard work though – Intensive English classes are lively, interactive and fun. Students are encouraged to speak English at all times, and benefit from using the language with others their own age in different social situations.

Students will have 15 hours of general English with the rest of the school then six additional lessons focused on improving their spoken English with a speaking exam at the end of their course.

Students also participate in sports, arts and crafts, and other activities. Aimed at practising English through fun and teamwork, the Intensive English programme proves that it is possible to work hard and still have fun!

There is one full-day and one half-day study trip included every week. Examples include: London walking tour and the London Eye, Oxford

The academic managers ensure day-to-day guidance and support for all teachers and they observe and monitor teachers' performance.

All our young learner staff have DBS checks and at least two references before they can work at our schools. We ensure a high number of our staff on site have first aid training.

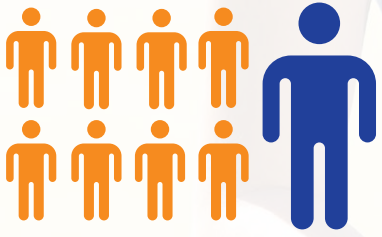

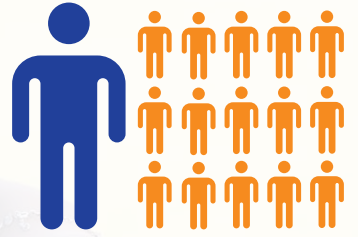
