ON-SITE COURSES

Group - Private - Combi

Book a **Group course** with 20 lessons per week or **Private classes** with min. 10 lessons. Choose a Group Course with 30+ lessons if you look for "**Bildungsurlaub**" (Germany).

Or combine group classes with private lessons:

- **Spanish PLUS** is ideal if you like to learn in groups, but also want to intensively work on your individual Spanish skills.
- **Spanish Interactive** takes you to the streets to help you practice your conversational skills under the guidance of your teacher outside the classroom.
- **Add a single Spanish Workshop** with a private tutor if you like to practice special skills, learn more about Dominican Culture, highlight certain topics you need for your job (Medical/ Business Spanish) or prepare for the DELE Spanish Exam.

All levels - all year round - starting weekly

Courses start every Monday for all language levels, total beginner to advanced (A1 to C2), also over the holidays. Groups are limited to 7 students. Take a course for one week only or study several months with us. It's completely up to you.

1. Santo Domingo

You love the vibes of a big city? Then immerse yourself in the urban life of a modern Caribbean metropolis.

With a population of over 3 million inhabitants and a 500-year old history, Santo Domingo, the capital of the Dominican Republic, is the cultural, political and economic center of the country.

- See the historical face of the city in its colonial district **Zona Colonial, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.**
- The METRO subway, the Museum of Modern Art, many art galleries and not at least the big Shopping Malls reflect the city's modern face.

At night, **Santo Domingo is full of Merengue and Bachata music.** Go to a fancy Dance Club or to one of the traditional dance places, often with live music played there.

Sunday nights, people **get together at “Las Ruinas”** in the Old Town. It’s a great place to meet people and practice your Spanish.

2. Sosúa

You love nature? You like to be active? Then learn Spanish with us in Sosua on the north coast of the Dominican Republic.

Sosúa is located only 10 minutes driving from the International Airport of Puerto Plata (POP). The small beach town, home to about 12,000 inhabitants, is known for its beautiful beaches and water sports facilities.

Only **15 minutes east** lies Cabarete, the "Capital of Wind and Surf", one of the best wind- and kite surfing spots in the world.

Due to its central location between the Cordillera Septentrional and the Atlantic, **Sosúa is the ideal place for all nature and sports enthusiasts** who like to explore the island's nature diversity or wish to combine studying Spanish with fun activities like swimming, hiking, cascading, standup paddling, snorkeling, scuba diving, and surfing.

Or you just chill on the beach.





ONLINE CLASSES

Spanish Online Classes – LIVE from the Dominican Republic

Learn Spanish online from the convenience of your home or office with a native Spanish teacher - LIVE from the Dominican Republic! It's almost like being here. Classes are arranged flexibly along your and our teachers' availability.

- Choose **your Private Online Tutor**. Classes can be 1x, 2x, up to 5x per week.
- **Blended learning**: Combine it with an On-site class if you either like to prepare yourself before you come to the Dominican Republic or when you want to keep on learning and practicing your conversational Spanish once you are back home. It's a great way to stay in touch and keep on learning.

How does it work?

The online classes are taught in a combined virtual classroom setting via ZOOM, WhatsApp or Google Meet Video chat, and Google Classroom. All materials are provided.

LODGING



In Santo Domingo

Student Residence - Shared Apartment: Single room, TV, closet, fans; shared bathroom, living room, kitchen; self-catering. Free WIFI. 2 min walking to school.

Host family: stay with Dominican middle-class family; single room, students' bath; free WIFI. Breakfast only or with half-board. Max. 30 min by public transport to school.

At both lodging options, private bathroom can be booked in addition.

In Santo Domingo and Sosúa

Economy or Mid-range Hotel: Single room, breakfast, private bath, A/C, WIFI, with roof terrace or pool. Hotels in 10 min walking from the school.

Airport pick-up can be booked with IIC as well.

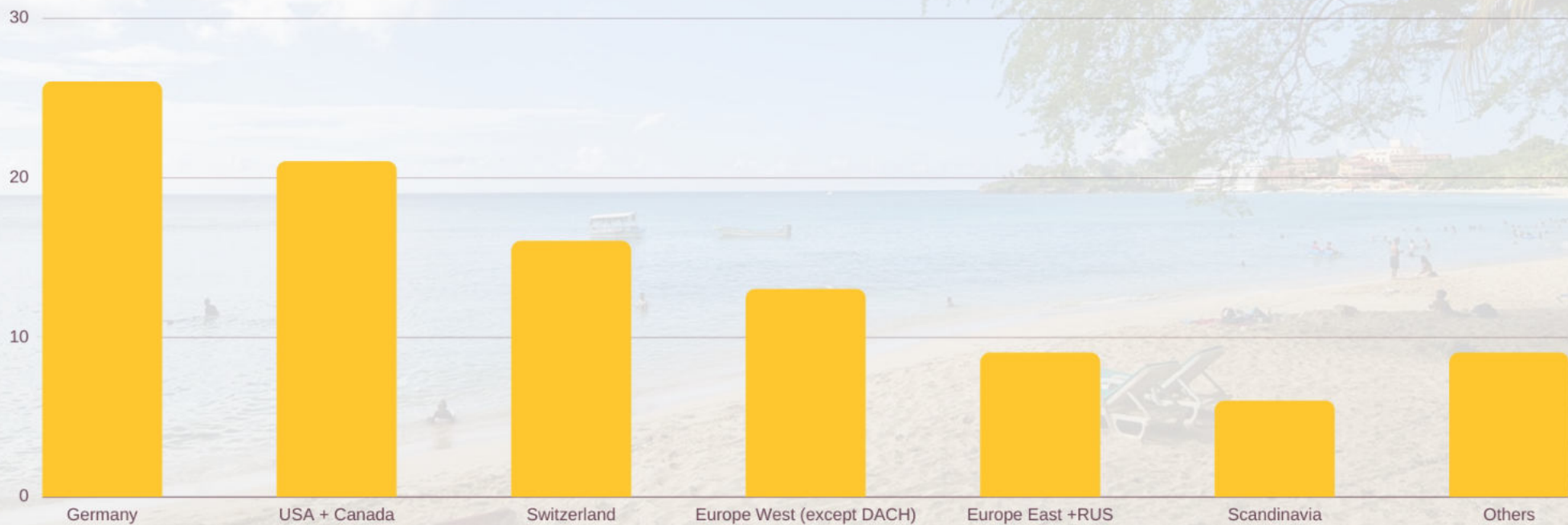

Where our Students come from

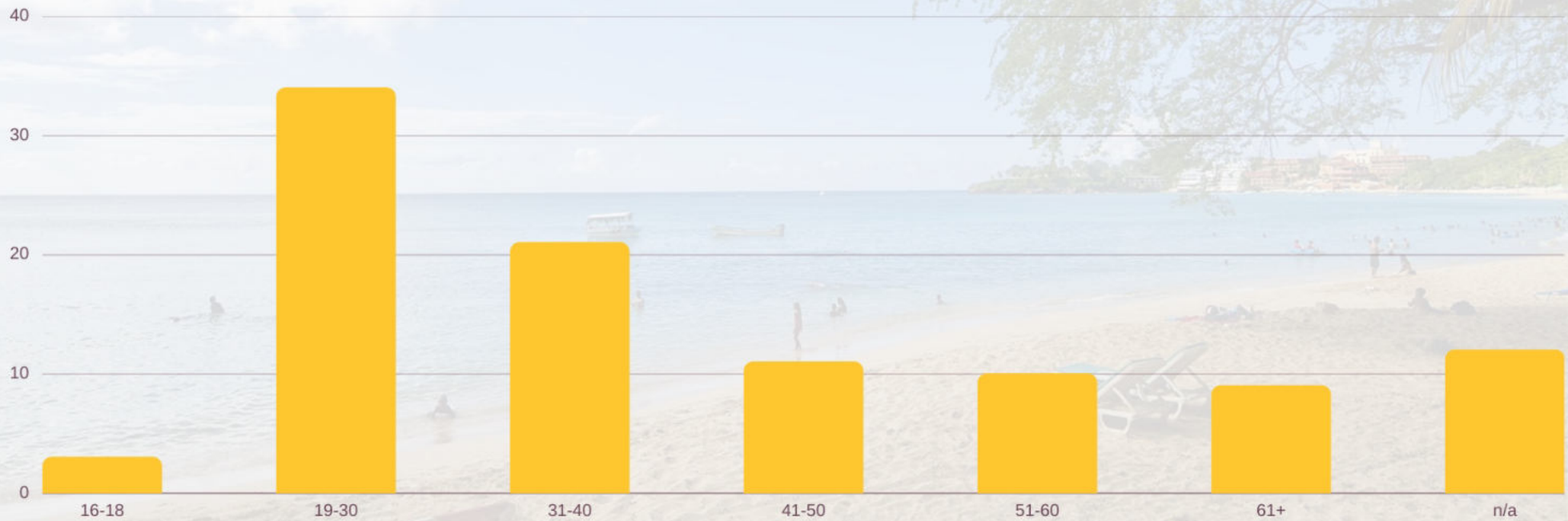
