THE ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSE

WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

The course will help younger learners on the practical aspects of Italian language and develop everyday communication skills, to enable students to improve all four skills: reading, writing, listening and speaking.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

The aim of the Italian course is to develop mainly practical and communication skills. By learning and practicing Italian in fun and focused lessons students will increase their confidence in using Italian, consolidating language knowledge and achieving greater fluency.

LEVELS

Course is available for students from beginner to advanced levels (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 of *CEF*)
On the first day beginner students will immediately start with their first Italian lesson. Students having a previous knowledge of Italian will take a written and oral placement test, so that we can place them in the appropriate group according to the Italian language level.

LEARNING MATERIAL

Textbook and extra learning material is provided by the school and included in the programme fee.

SCHEDULE

The programme offers 20 lessons per week arranged in 4 daily sessions, taking place from Monday to Friday in the morning or in the afternoon.

GROUP SIZE

Max. 14 students per group.

CERTIFICATE

At the end of your Italian course Linguaviva will provide a certificate showing the length of the course and the Italian language level achieved.

The Summer Programme for Juniors in Florence is enriched by a daily schedule of cultural and leisure activities organized and led by Linguaviva staff and fully included in the programme fee. These represent the opportunity to go on practicing Italian outside the school, to broaden the knowledge of Italian culture and to spend memorable time with new friends coming from all over the world.

ART HISTORY VISITS: Uffizi Gallery, Accademia Gallery, Duomo, Santa Croce, Santa Maria Novella, Boboli Garden

EXCURSIONS: Full day excursions to famous Italian cities and to most renowned sites like Siena and San Gimignano, Pisa, Lucca, Cinque Terre, and trips to Seaside are organized during the weekends, both on Saturdays and Sundays.

SEMINARS: Various aspects of contemporary Italian culture and society are presented (e.g. Italian Renaissance, Italian Songs, Italian Fashion, Italian Gestures).

CREATIVE ACTIVITIES: The programme is enriched by practical Art workshops and hands on Cooking lessons.

FULL BOARD ACCOMMODATION

At Linguaviva campus boys and girls are accommodated according to age, gender and nationality in rooms with 3 - 4 beds, private bathroom facilities and air conditioning.
